

**Town of Bear River  
Ordinance 2002-12  
Amendment of Ordinance  
2001-08**

**Whereas**, on the 25<sup>th</sup> day of June, 2002, the Town of Bear River would like to amend Ordinance 2001-08, **Section 11**: Rendition of judgment and assessment of punishment; confinement for neglect or refusal to pay judgment; production of sureties and confession of judgment; punishment for contempt.

If the defendant is found guilty, the municipal judge shall declare and assess punishment and render judgment accordingly.

Upon the rendition of judgment against any defendant for the violation of any provision of the Code or any other ordinance of the Town, the municipal judge shall make an order, and enter the same of his docket, that if the defendant shall neglect or refuse to satisfy such judgment and costs of suit, he shall be confined in jail or ordered by the municipal judge.

**Whereas**, the above written Section 11, shall exclude any jail time and read: he shall pay a \$750 fine. In any prosecution for violation of any provision of this Code or any other ordinance, the defendant may produce before the municipal judge one or more sureties to the satisfaction of the judge, which sureties shall, with the defendant, confess a judgment for the amount of the fine or penalty imposed including costs of suit. The judge shall enter the confession of judgment in the docket and render judgment accordingly in the name of the state for the amount of the fine and costs. If the judgment is not paid within ninety days from the date of the confession, the municipal judge shall issue execution and collect the amount of the fine or penalty and costs in the manner provided by law for collecting judgment by execution in justice of the peace courts.

**Now, Therefore Be It Ordained**, the Town of Bear River is excluding any jail time from Ordinance 2001-08 and will charge a fine of \$750.
