Resolution #2001-21

Approval of construction and repair of town roads, for the health and safety of the community:

WHEREAS THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE TOWN OF BEAR RIVER finds it necessary to make application for grant funding in the amount of \$278,475.00 for construction to certain roads, intersections and approaches, and

WHEREAS such funding will be applied for from one or more sources and,

WHEREAS such construction would consist of:

- a) Correction of approaches off of Highway 89 to Appaloosa, Deer Mountain Road, and Home Stretch, to meet original permit specifications.
- b) Improvements, (extent yet to be determined) to various roads (also to be determined) for the purpose of allowing Uinta County School Busses to reach new bus stop(s) for the children.
- c) To construct a new road leading from Highway 89 to the Town Hall.

And,

WHEREAS the Town of Bear River has been directed and advised by the Wyoming Department of Transportation, that items (a) and (b) be completed.

THEREFORE LET IT BE RESOLVED THAT THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE TOWN OF BEAR RIVER does find it necessary, for the health, safety and well being of the community, that an application for grant funding should be submitted by the town engineer, to assist in the cost for improvement and repair of the roadways within the town.
