**Resolution 02-001
Delinquent Water and Sewer Charges**

WHEREAS, THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE TOWN OF BEAR RIVER recognizes the need to amend **Resolution 01-011, A RESOLUTION TO ACCOMPANY THE 2001-2002 FISCAL YEAR BUDGET ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING ALL FEES, COSTS AND CHARGES TO BE COLLECTED FOR SERVICES, UTILITIES, SECURITY OR OTHER TOWN PURPOSES DURING THE 2001-2002 FISCAL YEAR, REPLEALER; AUTHORITY TO AMEND.**

WHEREAS, THE TOWN FINDS IT NECESSARY to implement a late fee for all delinquent water payments, which are 30 days past due, in the amount of \$10 per month. After 90 days past due, water shall be disconnected.

FURTHERMORE, THE TOWN FINDS IT NECESSARY to change the reconnect fee to the water system from \$45 to \$150 plus expenses. To reconnect, the customer must bring the delinquent bill current and pay the \$150 reconnect fee. The customer shall also be charged a \$300 deposit. The \$300 deposit shall be refunded in 12 months, if said customer’s bill is current at that time.

WHEREAS, FOR NEW WATER SERVICE CONNECTION there shall be a fee in the amount of \$1,000, as has been in the past, plus a deposit of \$300. The \$300 deposit shall be refunded to the customer in 12 months if said customer’s bill is current at that time.

WHEREAS, THE TOWN FINDS IT NECESSARY to implement a late fee for delinquent sewer payments, which are 30 days past due, in the amount of \$10 per month. After 90 days past due, sewer shall be disconnected.

FURTHERMORE, THE TOWN FINDS IT NECESSARY to implement a shut off/reconnect fee to the sewer system in the amount of \$150 plus expenses.

WHEREAS, FOR NEW SEWER SERVICE CONNECTION a fee of \$1,000 shall be charged, as has been in the past, plus a deposit of \$300. The \$300 deposit shall be refunded to the customer in 12 months if said customer’s bill is current at that time.

THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED THAT THE AFORE MENTIONED AMMENDMENTS BE IN PLACE HEREAFTER, UNTIL SUCH TIME AS THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE TOWN OF BEAR RIVER SEES FURTHER NEED TO AMMEND THIS RESOLUTION:
