**RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF BEAR RIVER TO ADOPT THE
UINTA COUNTY/MUNICIPAL EMERGENCY OPERATIONS PLAN.**

WHEREAS, THE TOWN OF BEAR RIVER, recognizes the need to have an Emergency Operations Plan in place to be prepared for Natural and Man-made disasters.

WHEREAS, a local emergency operations plan is required by W. S. 19-13-108 “Each political subdivision through the emergency management program will cause to be prepared a local emergency operating plan...”

WHEREAS, Uinta County Wyoming, has a Uinta County/Municipal Emergency Operations Plan in place that has been adopted by Uinta County, Evanston, Lyman and Mountain View.

WHEREAS, the adoption of the Uinta County/Municipal Emergency Operations Plan will enable Bear River to be in compliance with Wyoming State Statute and be eligible to apply for assistance under various state and federal programs.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF BEAR RIVER, WYOMING, THAT:

The Town of Bear River hereby authorizes the Adoption of the Uinta County/Municipal Emergency Operations Plan and the Mayor of Bear River is hereby authorized and directed to execute such instruments as may be necessary to effect said resolve.
