

Town of Bear River
Resolution 02-30
Non-payment of Monthly Sewer Fees

WHEREAS, THE TOWN OF BEAR RIVER, feel in order to provide sewer collection and treatment for residences in certain areas of town, monthly ongoing fees must be charged to pay for said collection system and treatment; and

WHEREAS, certain sewer users may from time to time fail or refuse to pay monthly and legally assessed sewer fees; and

WHEREAS, it is unfair to users that pay required fees and since failure to pay may create financial hardship on the sewer system and create expenses to collect unpaid fees; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the citizens of Bear River to have in place a policy dealing with sewer non-payment and the assessment of late fees to recover costs of collection and discourage non-payment.

THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF BEAR RIVER THAT:

Section One: There is hereby created a late payment fee in the amount of TEN DOLLARS (\$10.00) that is charged and added to the account of any sewer system users that are delinquent on monthly payment for more than 30 days.

Section Two: There is hereby created a late payment fee in the amount of ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00) that will be charged and added to the account of any sewer system user that is delinquent in payment for more than 90 days.

Section Three: There is hereby established a policy that at such time that any sewer users account is delinquent more than 120 days, an action in the small claims court of Uinta County will be filed against that sewer user to collect all outstanding balances on the sewer account and all costs of suit and collection, including attorney's fees. The Town Council may defer or halt the filing of suit, on terms deemed appropriate to the Council.
