

**TOWN OF BEAR RIVER, WYOMING
RESOLUTION 2003-09**

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A JOINT APPLICATION WITH THE CITY OF EVANSTON, TO THE WYOMING WATER DEVELOPMENT COMMISSION, FOR A LEVEL II STUDY OF THE BEAR RIVER VALLEY WATER DISTRIBUTION SYSTEM; MAYOR AND CLERK AUTHORIZED TO SIGN.

WHEREAS, The North Uinta County Improvement and Service District (NUCISD), in 2000, made application to the Wyoming Water Development Commission (WWDC) for a Study of a potential water distribution system from the City of Evanston to the areas north of Evanston; and

WHEREAS, a Level I study was completed and it indicated that a Level II study of the proposed system was justified; and

WHEREAS, since the original application was submitted to the WWDC the Town of Bear River was incorporated and assumed all functions of the NUCISD, including the water distribution system and responsibility for the Level II study; and

WHEREAS, after public hearings and consultation with the City of Evanston, the Town and Evanston now propose to make a formal joint application to the WWDC for a Level II Study; and

WHEREAS, the application for a Level II study must be authorized by the Bear River Town Council and signed by the Mayor and Town Clerk.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF BEAR RIVER, WYOMING, THAT:

Section One. A joint application, with the City of Evanston, and to the Wyoming Water Development Commission, for a Level II study of a water distribution system to deliver water to all areas north of Evanston, including the Town of Bear River, is hereby authorized to be prepared and submitted on behalf of the Town.

Section Two. The Mayor and Town Clerk are hereby authorized to execute all documents necessary to make application to the WWDC as provided herein.
